#### PROJECT

##### 2025-0225 FIRE SUPPRESSION EC-BHT

#### PROJECT OVERVIEW

The project involves the installation of a fire suppression system for a mini-theater space measuring approximately 14' 9 1/2" x 16' 3" (approximately 240 sq ft). The walls are approximately 10 1/4" thick. A key architectural feature is a 12' diameter dome in the center of the room, which serves as a projection screen. Proposals must include the cost of pulling necessary permits and include an installation time frame.

## DELIVERABLES AND DELIVERY SCHEDULE

### Project Requirements

- **Fire Suppression System Design and Installation:**
  - Provide a comprehensive fire suppression system design that complies with all applicable building codes and regulations.
  - The system must provide adequate fire protection for the entire mini-theater space.
  - Proposals should prioritize minimizing the number of sprinkler heads within the dome area, if permissible by code.
  - Proposals should explore options for suppressing the area above the dome and the room below the dome, if permissible by code, avoiding sprinkler heads in the dome.
  - Integrate the new system with the existing fire suppression system that protects the roof outside the mini-theater.
  - Provide all necessary equipment, materials, and labor for the complete installation of the fire suppression system.
  - Conduct all necessary testing and inspections to ensure the system's proper functionality.
  - Provide detailed documentation of the installed system, including as-built drawings and operating manuals.
- **Minimization of Installation Time:**
  - Proposals must clearly outline the proposed project timeline, with a focus on minimizing the total installation time.
  - Proposals should specify the estimated time required for each phase of the project.

- **Code Compliance:**
  - Proposals must demonstrate a thorough understanding of all applicable building codes and fire safety regulations.
